Except for the syndicated stories, I have located and read every item listed in this bibliography. I have not listed the few items on Shirley Sargent's own 1980 bibliography which I have been unable to locate. Many of the citations are incomplete, for they refer to items, mainly newspaper clippings from Shirley's files, which did not contain complete information.

All the materials listed here, except Shirley's books and syndicated stories, are now on file at the Yosemite National Park Archives in El Portal for the use of researchers.

No doubt users of this bibliography will be as amazed as I was to discover the astounding breadth, depth and quality of Shirley Sargent's writings. I hope it will be of some use to those who continue to cherish Shirley's legacy.
